

Patterdale Parish Community Flood Group – Beck Work List

The list of work below is a summary of the main beck work to be completed within Patterdale Parish between June and September 2016. The purpose of this document is to serve as a single list for use by the consenting authorities. All work to be carried out by the Community Flood Group will adhere to the following criteria:

1. All work will be carried out in the “permitted” window of June to September
2. All work will be carried out by agreed contractors who have worked with the EA in the Parish since December 2015 and conform to the H&S requirements and will be working under the direction of the Community Flood Group and will be paid for by the Community Flood Group
3. Full permission for all work has already been agreed with the relevant landowners
4. The specific work required has already been discussed in detail with the relevant agencies, for example the EA and Natural England. If specific further guidance is required this will be sought on a case by case basis.

| 1 | Glenridding Beck Mouth to Ullswater | Glenridding Sailing Centre/Ullswater Steamers | Clear centre beck mouth channel to ensure steady flow into the lake until the banks on either side have been fully stabilised | Community Flood Group |
| 2 | Glenridding Beck from Village Hall down to below Glenridding Hotel | Highways/LDNP/ Glenridding Hotel/Glenridding Sailing Centre | In addition to the beck wall repairs work is needed to clear gravel and stone in this stretch including under Glenridding Bridge. This work will be done whilst the wall repairs are completed | EA/Glenridding Hotel Contractors |
| 3 | Grisedale Beck below Grisedale Bridge | Matson Ground Estates | Infill holes at the bottom of the beck wall as required in the lane leading to Grisedale Bridge Houses | Community Flood Group |
| 4 | Grisedale Beck in the Grisedale Valley | Matson Ground Estates | Beck clearance and beck management as part of the agreed upstream management plan being developed in conjunction with Eden Rivers Trust | Community Flood Group |
| 5 | Goldrill Beck from Goldrill Bridge to Patterdale School | Choice Hotels | Selective removal of gravel deposits to alleviate river flow and prevent repeat flooding of Patterdale CofE Primary School | Community Flood Group |
| 6 | Goldrill Beck from Side Farm Bridge to mouth of Ullswater | Choice Hotels | Selective removal of gravel specifically just past the junction of Goldrill and Grisedale Beck | Community Flood Group |

| 7 | Goldrill Beck by Old Water View in Patterdale | Highways/Old Water View | Shoring up of the beck bank under the road to prevent further undermining | Highways/Community Flood Group |
| 8 | Deepdale behind Lanefoot Cottages | Lanefoot Cottage Owners | Reinstatement of the beck bank | Community Flood Group |
| 9 | Deepdale Bridge | Highways | Selective clearance of stones from under Deepdale Bridge to ease the flow to Deepdale Cottages and Lanefoot and to protect the bridge | Community Flood Group |
| 10 | Goldrill Beck in Hartsop from CowBridge north to Deepdale | Highways | Repair of the beck bank underneath the road to resolve undermining issues and prevent the A592 doing an "A591" | Highways |
| 11 | Hayeswater Gill from Horsemans Bridge to the junction of Goldrill Beck | National Trust | Stabilisation of the beck bank on the north side of the Gill as part of the "reservoir" protection for Brotherswater to protect the A592 | EA |
| 12 | Hayeswater Gill under Horsemans Bridge and up to Hartsop Village | Wear Family/Langton Adventure Centre/Highways | Stabilisation of the north side bank, clearance of the stone under Horsemans Bridge (to be done manually) and further selective work up the beck as required | Community Flood Group |
| 13 | Hartsop Hall (Caudale Beck, Caiston Beck, Kirkstone Beck) | National Trust | Repair work on becks to agreed specification of the National Trust and the Tenant Farmer of Hartsop Hall | National Trust |
